	<ul> <li>Regular monitoring of parameters such as Odours, Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC), Particulate Matter, Carbon dioxide and Noise</li> <li>Damp conditions:</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Ensuring that HVAC and cooling equipment are properly designed and operated to eliminate chronic respirational health issues.</li> <li>Properly controlling temperature and relative humidity for thermal comfort.</li> </ul>
